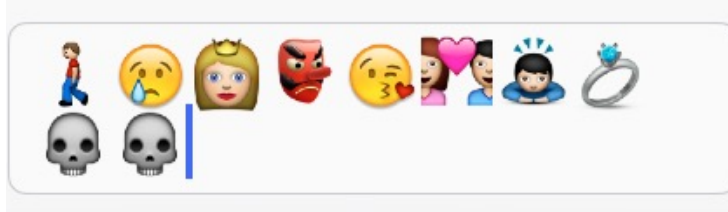


Shakespeare Visual Translation  
A.R.T. Technical

Your task:

You will be working in small groups to retell the plot of one Shakespearean play in images (you can use words, but the images should convey the majority of the message).

Your retelling should:

- ★ capture the main elements of the story (including theme)
- ★ incorporate technical elements (i.e. represent your characters in costume, on a set, etc.)
- ★ be engaging
- ★ communicate your understanding of the play

Your retelling might:

- ★ place this play in an alternate setting (e.g. *All's Well That Ends Well* set in 1920s Hollywood)
- ★ use other fictional characters (e.g. Harry Potter as Hamlet)

Steps:

1. Read summaries of the play (The Folger Library editions have summaries before each scene. Hint, hint. Nudge, nudge). **Due Friday 4/10**
2. Write your own summary of the play. **Due Tuesday 4/14**
3. Create a moodboard/storyboard for your visual translation. **Due Monday 4/27**
4. Turn your moodboard/storyboard into a large visual translation, which will hang in the hallway display case. **Due Friday 5/1**
